



Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy was last updated on June 25, 2018.

I-Meta Inc makes the same commitment to privacy for our Web site visitors as for our customers using our web-hosted service. We created this Online Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy") to give you confidence as you visit and use the I-Meta Inc Web site, located at www.spice-chip.com (the "Web site") and to demonstrate our commitment to the protection of your privacy. This Privacy Policy is only applicable to the Web site, and not to any other Web sites that you may be able to access from the Web site, each of which may have data collection and use practices and policies that differ materially from this Privacy Policy. Information Collection Practices

What Basic Information Does I-Meta Inc Collect?

You can visit the Web site to read information about our company, products, and services without telling us who you are and without revealing any personal information. In operating the Web site, I-Meta Inc includes optional information request forms such as White Paper or Webinar Request forms and general contact request forms that request your name, company, title, phone number, email address, URL, address and other information to help us determine your needs related to our products and solutions and in order for you to download or view documents or other information through the I-Meta Inc Web site. We use this information to send updates about our company and to contact you if requested or necessary. I-Meta Inc also collects billing information such as credits and eCheck data via our partnering with PeopleVine and its association with Paypal. Depending upon your request, I-Meta Inc may also ask for additional information, such as how you heard about us. This information is provided by you on a voluntary basis only and is not required by us in order for you to use and enjoy the Web site. I-Meta Inc uses the information that we collect on the Web site to contact you to further discuss your interest in our company, our services, and to send information regarding our company or partners, such as marketing promotions and events. This information may also be used to improve the services we provide you. We use this information to improve the way that we provide our services to our clients, to relay administrative information, and to verify login information. The information is collected and stored in a manner that is appropriate for the nature of the data that we collect, and the need to fulfill your request. I-Meta Inc does not share, sell, rent, or trade PII with third parties for their promotional purposes.

I-Meta Inc Clients – Customer and Vendor Members

If you are a client of I-Meta Inc (or work on behalf of a I-Meta Inc client), through our secure web interface we also collect your username and password, and any other information that you provide to us on behalf of the client that you are representing pursuant to the terms of a license or other agreement between the applicable client and I-Meta Inc (the "Client Agreement"). You should refer to our Terms and Conditions in addition to this Privacy Policy with regard to your use of the I-Meta Inc Web site and I-Meta Inc's privacy obligations.

Automatic Collection

Our servers automatically recognize visitors' IP addresses (the number assigned to computers on the Internet), domain names, the activity of the visitor's browser when the visitor is viewing the Web site; the site path of visitors; the time visitors come to the Web site and length of visit. No personal information about you is revealed in the process. The Web site may also gather anonymous traffic data that does not personally identify you, but that may be helpful for marketing purposes or for improving the services we offer and I-Meta Inc reserves the right to publish such anonymous, aggregate summary information regarding its visitors for promotional purposes.

I-Meta Inc uses "cookies" and "web beacons" to collect data. A cookie is a small text file containing a random and unique identifier that either I-Meta Inc or its third party web analytics provider on behalf of I-Meta Inc transfer to your computer's hard drive through your web browser (unless you set your browser to reject cookies) that enables I-Meta Inc or its third party web analytics provider's system to recognize your browser. I-Meta Inc uses cookies to track your movement through the Web site and verify the login status of client using products or services linked directly within the I-Meta Inc Web site.

Cookies are also used to track point of entry to point of registration for those users participating in our affiliate signup programs or to track and measure the success of a particular marketing campaign. Web beacons (also known as clear gifs) are typically a transparent graphic image (usually 1 pixel x 1 pixel) that is placed on a site and used by I-Meta Inc and its third party web analytics provider in combination with cookies to help us understand how you with the I-Meta Inc Web site. We use web beacons to measure visitor behavior, to help us improve visitor experience, and to manage site content.

Cookies

We use cookies to try and give you a better experience. Our privacy policy details how we use these cookies. If you don't like cookies, you can disable them altogether too. Cookies allow us, among other things, to store your preferences and settings; enable you to sign-in; provide interest-based advertising; combat fraud; and analyze how our services are performing.

By continuing to use our site, you agree to the way we use cookies and are ok with it as described in our Privacy Policy, unless you choose to disable them altogether through your browser. You have a variety of tools to control cookies, web beacons and similar technologies, including browser controls to block and delete cookies and controls from some third-party analytics service providers to opt out of data collection through web beacons. Your browser and other choices may impact your experiences with our services.

Security and Privacy

I-Meta Inc's web site uses security measures to help protect against the loss, misuse, and alteration of the information under our control. We store the information in two redundant databases in two secure environments at different locations with our data hosting service provider, Yahoo Small Business, as well as integration with our partner, PeopleVine.

I-Meta Inc takes care to reinforce the importance of our web site visitors' security and privacy among our employees. I-Meta Inc requires unique usernames and passwords that must be entered each time a user logs on to I-Meta Inc's client interface. These safeguards help prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the appropriate use of all data. The bottom line is that, because our business involves hosting application accounts, data security is paramount. We're constantly reevaluating and deploying new technologies to enhance our security.

In order to accommodate changes in our business, we may sell or buy portions of our company or other companies or assets. In such transactions, visitor information may be one of the transferred assets. In the event that all or substantially all of I-Meta Inc's assets are acquired in a transaction, our visitor information may be an asset that is reviewed and transferred. Such a transaction will be disclosed per the "Notification of Privacy Policy Changes" guidelines above. Also, as with the data we collect on behalf of our clients, we reserve the right to disclose any data we collect at our Web site if required by law or valid order of a court or other governmental authority or to protect the health and safety of I-Meta Inc's employees or the general public.
